3. Counsel hereby acknowledges that Rule 14 of the *Uniform Rules of Youth Court Practice*, in pertinent part, provides

Once an attorney is deemed of record that attorney shall continue to represent the party in all proceedings pertaining to the case except upon a withdrawal of counsel An attorney who has made an entry of appearance shall not be permitted to withdraw from the case until a timely appeal has been decided, except by leave of court after a notice of withdrawal has been served on the party which counsel represents.

4. Counsel hereby acknowledges that continuances are not granted without court approval and Counsel shall (a) appear on or before the scheduled appearance time; (b) be available until 5:00 PM on the scheduled hearing date; and (c) remain until excused by the court.

5. Counsel hereby acknowledges that he/she understands that failure of Counsel to timely appear for a hearing and failure of Counsel to remain until excused by the court may be punishable by contempt and that the maximum penalty, per occurrence, for contempt in youth court is ninety (90) days in jail and a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
